DO YOU RECYCLE BOTTLES AND CANS?

If you recycle the bottles and cans, please consider donating your redeemable bottles and cans to the Fowler Middle School Parent Support Organization.

Each redeemable bottle or can is worth 10 cents.

The PSO supports classroom support and incentives, educational field trips, 8th grade celebration (since there is no graduation ceremony), sponsors school dances, etc.

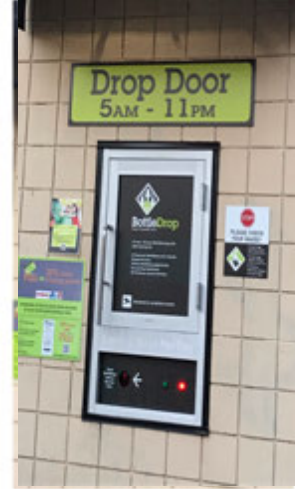
How can you help?

You can fill a blue Bottle Drop bag at home. When it's full you can drop it off at the Bottle Drop center located in Canterbury Square on Hwy 99 just north of Bull Mountain Road. No need to stand in line! Open 5am - 11pm in the back of the building.

The folks at the bottle drop count the contents and credit the Fowler PSO account.

What if it takes me a year to fill a bag? NO PROBLEM! This is an on-going fundraiser!

Maybe you have a neighbor or two who could help you fill a bag or would like their own bag(s) to fill? Spread the word and help the Fowler PSO effectively recycle and earn money to help fund its programs.

ASK YOUR FRIENDS AND NEIGHBORS TO PARTICIPATE AND GET BAGS FOR THEM TOO!

Fill it up
ADD ANY BOTTLES OR CANS THAT HAVE AN OREGON REDEMPTION VALUE NOTED

Drop it off
DROP OFF YOUR BAG AT ANY BOTTLEDROP LOCATION (CLOSEST IS HWY 99/BULL MT.)
YOU CAN DRIVE AROUND BACK TO THE BACK DOOR FOR EASY, HASSLE-FREE DROP OFF.!

Important!

Effective January 1, 2018, all beverage containers between 4 oz and 1.5 liters are redeemable EXCEPT distilled liquor, wine, dairy, or plant-based milk and infant formula. This means that tea, coffee, hard cider, fruit juice, kombucha and coconut water will now be redeemable as of January 1, 2018.

The bags cannot weigh more than 20 pounds (so mix in plastic bottle and aluminum cans with those glass bottles). Each blue bag costs the Fowler PSO 20 cents to purchase and 35 cents to process the contents, so please only turn in full bags.
